


# **Neurodiversity-Affirming Support**

  - Focus on inclusivity, not conformity



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
# Ableism is a set of discriminatory beliefs and practices about the disability community. Anything or anyone that perpetuates harmful beliefs is considered to be engaging, acting or speaking in an ableist way. Ableism an beseen in schools policies, accessibility, accommodations language norms, intervention recommendation norms, reports, etc. Ableism has a spectrum damaging consequences in schools Lack of inclusion & limited accessibility Negative & harmful stereotypes














# The Power of Inclusive Language





## Inclusive language:
